SEWER REPAIR WORK ON COURT STREET, SUMMER STREET, LONG POND ROAD, WESTERLY ROAD & BRALEY ROAD

The Town seeks to advise residents that its sewer repair contractor, Albanese D&S, will continue its seventeenth week of work on the Town's sewer force main at the following locations:

Westerly Road, between Summer Street and the Route 3 Exit 6 Off-Ramp at Samoset Street – Work will continue on the portion of Westerly Road between Summer Street and the Route 3 / Exit 6 off-ramp from Monday, September 26th through Friday, September 30th, 2016, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Please be advised that this section of road will be closed to all through traffic, during both the daytime work schedule and during overnight hours.

Westerly Road, between Samoset Street and Alden Street - Work will continue within the stockpile area on the portion of Westerly Road between Samoset Street and Alden Street, from Monday, September 26th through Friday, September 30th, 2016. This work will occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. During the scheduled work, Westerly Road will be closed to all traffic between Samoset and Royal. Traffic will be detoured through Royal Street.

Braley Road – Work will continue on Braley Road from Monday, September 26th through Friday, September 30th, 2016, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Braley Road will be closed to all through traffic during construction hours. The temporary access road established from Billington Street to Braley Road will be open for residents/deliveries during construction hours.

Upcoming Work on Summer Street at Westerly Road – The installation of the sewer main across Summer Street at Westerly Road is estimated to begin during the first week in October. Please be advised that Summer Street will be closed at this location to all traffic for several days to allow for pipe installation. Residents should expect detours and traffic delays.

Upcoming Work on Long Pond Road at Exit 5 – The installation of the sewer main across Long Pond Road at Route 3 / Exit 5 is expected to start in the next few weeks. This work will be conducted during evening hours (7:00 p.m. through 6:00 a.m.), to minimize traffic delays. The Long Pond Road crossing will be the final major roadway crossing within the sewer repair project.
