Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Program

The Town of Plymouth's 2016-2020 Consolidated Plan is available for public review and comment. The Consolidated Plan is a five-year planning strategy required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) which identifies housing and community needs primarily of low and moderate income residents in the Town. The plan describes a five-year revitalization strategy and sets out goals and objectives to address the needs using available federal HUD funds and state and local resources.

Development of the Consolidated Plan was augmented through consultation with local housing and social service providers and adjacent communities. The plan identifies realistic annual goals and opportunities for annual assessment of the Town's performance.

Also available is the FY-2016 Action Plan, which describes the activities for the program year and the amount of Community Development Block Grant funds to be spent on each. In addition, the Action Plan summarizes the priorities and specific objectives that will be addressed in the program year and relates them to the priority needs listed in the Consolidated Plan.

A thirty-day public comment period is in effect from April 1 through April 30, 2016. Both documents are available at the Office of Community Development, 11 Lincoln Street.
