GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth, you are directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of Plymouth qualified to vote in elections, to meet in:

in said Plymouth on Saturday, the Tenth Day of May, 2014, between the hours of Eight O'Clock in the forenoon and Eight O'Clock in the afternoon, to cast a vote for the following Town Officers to act on the following articles to wit:

ARTICLE 1: To choose all necessary Town Officers, the following to be voted for all on one ballot, viz.:

Two Selectmen for three years; Two members of the Plymouth School Committee for three years; One member of the Planning Board for five years; One member of the Redevelopment Authority for five years; One member of the Housing Authority and also a total of Forty-nine (49) Town Meeting Members, Three members from each precinct for three years, One member from Precinct 2, One member from Precinct 9 and One member from Precinct 13 for two years, and one member from Precinct 11 for one year;

AND to vote on the following question: *

“QUESTION 1

This question is not binding; Should the people of the Town of Plymouth encourage the Town's government to employ all means available to ensure that spent nuclear fuel generated at the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station be placed in dry cask storage as soon as technologically feasible and consistent with the highest standards and in anticipation of such spent fuel's ultimate and permanent disposition in a federally sponsored national or regional storage facility, all in order to protect the health, welfare, and economic interests of the Town of Plymouth and its inhabitants.

Summary:

This question asks voters if they are in favor of the Town government efforts to encourage the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station to place spent nuclear fuel into dry cask storage using the highest standards and as soon as technologically feasible to protect the inhabitants of the Town of Plymouth.

A YES VOTE informs the Town's government that voters are in favor of ensuring that Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station place spent nuclear fuel into dry cask storage using the highest standards and as soon as technically possible.

A NO VOTE calls for no action by the Town's government.
