Boating Access Rules And Regulations

1. A completed boating access application must be presented to the Parks Forestry Division at least 30 days prior to event for approval
2. Parking is on a first come first serve basis. Parking is for vehicles with boat trailers or vehicles with car top boats. This permit does not guarantee the availability of parking for this event
3. Maximum of two weekend permits will be issued to any organization for the use of any one facility. Two day events will be considered two permits.
4. All participants in the event must be notified in an appropriate manner so that the Town of Plymouth shall not be held liable for personal injuries or damages to property and a copy of the notification is to be provided to the Parks and Forestry Division.
5. Upon completion of said event the facility must be left clean and in a litter-free state. A carry in carry out expectation is in place. Any and all damages to said facility or grounds shall be repaired to the satisfaction of the Park and Forestry Division.
6. The applicant shall keep a written record of all participants in the event and able to produce said record upon request
7. The applicant is responsible for traffic control and public safety through the Plymouth Police Department. A Police or Environmental Police Officer may be required for the duration of the event.
8. The applicant or an appointed representative shall display the permit in his or her vehicle windshield in a visible manner.
9. All posted rules and regulations shall be followed
10. Parking Fees are in effect Memorial Day through Labor Day
11. Bathrooms may or may not be open
12. Should bathrooms not be open portable toilets may be required
13. Drop off of portable toilets shall not be earlier than the day before the event
14. Pick up of portable toilets shall be no later than the day after the event
15. Permits may be revoked for misuse of the Park
16. Boat ramp access must be accessible at all times
17. All access and egress throughout the park and boat ramp area must remain accessible and open at all times.
