POLICY: COMMUNITY CLEANLINESS

1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to insure the cleanliness and attractiveness of the community as well as to protect the health, safety, and well-being of the residents and visitors of Plymouth.

2.0 POLICY GUIDELINES

- 2.1 Homeowners and tenants are urged to keep their premises free of litter and debris so that the neighborhoods are both healthful and aesthetically pleasing. The Chamber of Commerce, the Plymouth Center Association and all other business associates are also urged to cooperate in the spirit of this policy.
- 2.2 Places of business, both wholesale and retail, offices, and industry are responsible for keeping sidewalks and passageways clear of litter, debris, snow, ice and other obstructions generated from the nature of the occupied premise whether the premise is owned or leased. Daily removal of such litter, garbage, or debris from sidewalks and passageways shall be observed and enforced.
- 2.3 In addition, shopping centers and malls shall be responsible for monitoring their parking lots, plantings, and barrier areas to remove litter and debris and insure cleanliness and general aesthetic appearance.
- 2.4 "Removal" shall not be construed as movement of debris to gutters or outlying areas of the premises but disposal shall be to legally established collection points, landfills, or disposal agencies located off the premises.
- 2.5 The Directors of Health, Department of Public Works, and the Police are directed to monitor and/or enforce the foregoing.

2.6 All licenses as common victualers and purveyors of food and all leases of town property will be issued or renewed only when in compliance with the foregoing. Licenses for businesses involved with food, both original and renewals, will be issued only with the approval of the Director of Health. Reference: 105 CMR 590.00 State Sanitary Code Chapter X.
