- The RFP discusses incorporation of EMAP standards (Section G.1). However the aforementioned section is the only mention of EMAP in the RFP. Is the Town seeking EMAP accreditation or does it just wish to use and integrate EMAP standards?

The Town may choose to seek EMAP accreditation in the future, and the planning conducted should comply appropriately with current accreditation standards.

2. The insurance requirements have been revised to include the following, in addition to the limits listed in the RFP:

Architects and Engineers Professional Liability
(applicable for any architects or engineers involved in the project) of at least \$1,000,000/occurrence, \$3,000,000 aggregate.
