OPTIONS	HELPFUL INFORMATION/ WHAT MAY I RECYCLE?
<p>Curbside</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ABC will provide subscriber with 2 barrels- a 65 gallon barrel for trash and a 95 gallon barrel for recyclables. • All trash must be disposed of in orange Pay As You Throw bags. Bags costs \$6.25 for five 30-gallon bags or \$6.25 for eight 15-gallon bags. Bags may be purchased from area stores including: CVS, Walgreens, both Plymouth Shaw's and Stop & Shop Locations, Hannaford's, Mayflower Food & Spirits, Mobil in Cedarville on State Rd., Perry's Market, Village General Store, White Horse General Store, Benny's in Plymouth and E. Wareham, Aubuchon, The Corner Store, Manomet Liquors, The Market – Pinehills, The Store at Sandy Pond Campground. • Trash pickup is once a week and recycling pickup is once every other week. • You may recycle glass, plastics (#'s 1-7), metal cans, newspaper, cardboard and office paper. Do not place yard waste, concrete, rock, demolition debris, household hazardous waste or hot ashes in the trash. • Please place all shredded paper in a clear plastic bag inside the recycling barrel. • Latex paint, if dried out, may be thrown away in the trash. Save oil based paints for the semi-annual household hazardous waste days. • If you have large bulky items you wish to dispose of, please call ABC at 800-310-9111 and ask for a pickup. There is a charge for all bulky pickups.
<p>Transfer Station</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may recycle glass, plastics (#'s 1-7), metal cans, newspaper, cardboard and office paper. You may also recycle scrap metal, leaves, grass, tires, TV's, waste oil, anti-freeze and textiles at the transfer station. There is a nominal charge for the recycling of tires and TV's, as well as for the removal of freon from AC's and refrigerators. • All trash must be disposed of in orange Pay As You Throw bags. Bags costs \$6.25 for five 30-gallon bags or \$6.25 for eight 15-gallon bags. Bags may be purchased from area stores. • For those using the Transfer Station, hours of operation are Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Friday from 8am-4pm
