1.0 PURPOSE

To create a policy for the regulation of fee exemption consideration in the " _
Town of Plymouth.

2.0 POLICY GUIDELINES

The Board will not consider requests for waiving of town fees for community related events, charitable organizations, non profit organizations, governmental boards, committees and commissions and groups granted exempt status by the Board of Selectmen or their designee.

3.0 APPLICABILITY

This policy applies to all departments and divisions that are responsible for renting town facilities and/or issuing licenses and permits for community related events and fund raisers either on town or private property.

License and permit fees required under state and federal law as well as any custodial overtime and other contractual requirements are not covered under this policy.
