POLICY: TOWN WHARF FUELING REGULATIONS

BOS/90/01/R01

Revised: July 13, 2004

1.0 PURPOSE

- To require anyone fueling on the town wharf to abide by the following regulations:

2.0 POLICY GUIDELINES

The fueling restriction begins on May 1st of each year and runs through the day after Labor Day of the same year

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

- 1) Fueling shall take place only between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- 2) A 1,000 gallon minimum be established for fueling boats to keep the number of trucks and fueling operations at a safe level.
- 3) Fueling operations shall be carried out in a safe manner and the Harbor Master's Office be authorized to cease fueling operation at any time for unsafe conditions.
- 4) Fueling of vessels by Mobile Tank Vehicles shall only be allowed on the concrete section of Town Wharf.

3.0 APPLICABILITY

Anyone wishing to fuel on the Town Wharf or portion thereof.
