Commingled Containers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glass bottles & jars • Rigid plastic containers marked with a recycling logo with #1-7 • Steel, tin & aluminum cans • Foil and pie plates • Empty steel aerosol cans • Milk & juice cartons • Juice boxes • Cream & creamer containers • Rinse out food, labels are OK 	Items not acceptable include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Broken glass • Cups, dishes, plates, Pyrex, glass windows, light bulbs, ceramics, mirrors, crystal • Plastic bags or food wrap • Styrofoam • Automotive fluid bottles • Ice cream boxes • Margarine or cream cheese boxes
