Chairperson Clare Montanari called the meeting to order at 6 p.m.

The caucus accepted the minutes of February 28, 2023 and March 28, 2023, with David Peck abstaining forth vote of the March minutes because he did not attend.

Ginny Davis introduced Aminta Seery as a potential write-in candidate for the May 20th annual town election to fill the seat of David Peck who will run unopposed for the planning board.

Bill Abbott, Charter Commission chairman, spoke in favor of the proposed charter. He was asked to respond to the charge that the proposed charter would deter businesses from locating in Plymouth. He responded the charter would make Plymouth attractive to business because it would improve the quality of life.

Scott Vecchi said an opening exists on the Redevelopment Authority.
