**FENCE AND SIGNS AT WHB PUBLIC ENTRANCE**

**VICTORY GARDEN**

Member Bill Arienti presented a suggestion for a project to build a victory community garden at the Foothills along Beaver Dam Rd. His vision includes participation from the Boy and Girl Scouts. Things which would be needed for this project would include an approval from the Town, bringing in loam and fertilizer, a solar powered pumping system to access water from the pond, fencing. A motion was made by Dave Golden and seconded by Jeanette Kelly to support Bill's pursuing the development of this project.

### **OLD BUSINESS/NEW BUSINESS**

Jeanette Kelly reported that the crosswalk at Marshland is still in the works. An agreement as to the best location is needed.

Dave Golden reported that he sought information from local PD concerning effects of “nips” on DUIs. It was suggested that before pursuing any actions towards a nip ban our committee reach out to other steering committees for their input. It was agreed to consult with Chair Alice Baker.
