The Allerton Street Park renovations would include a new playground area, ADA accessible pathways to the playground, replacement of the existing fence with wooden guardrail, and loaming/seeding the entire park turf area. The playground area would include ADA accessible poured in place rubber surfacing with ADA accessible equipment and pathways. The playground area would also be relocated to the northeast side of the park. The existing fence will be removed and replaced by wooden guardrail on three sides of the park as the existing fence currently needs multiple costly repairs and will continue to be problematic. The wooden guardrail will also serve as a safety barrier, preventing vehicles from accessing the park, as well provide aesthetic value to the park.

Allerton Street Park Improvements

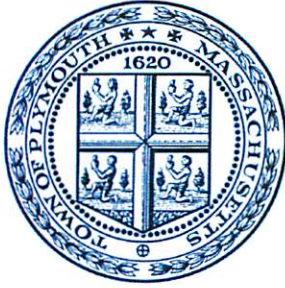
