



### **Town of Plymouth Department of Public Works, Sewer Division CMOM Project Background**

In 2014, in accordance with the EPA Clean Water Act Administrative Order Docket No. 13-006, the Town of Plymouth developed a Capacity, Management, Operation and Maintenance (CMOM) Corrective Action Plan. The primary purpose of the EPA-mandated CMOM Corrective Action Plan was to develop an implementation schedule for addressing deficiencies in the sewer collection system. Although multi-faceted, the Town's approved CMOM plan includes a schedule to inspect all sixty (60) miles of sewer mains and 1,500 sewer manholes in the Town's wastewater collection system every 5 years. As part of this year of the CMOM sewer inspection program, the Town will be inspecting approximately 20 miles of sewers and 500 manholes within the downtown area of the municipal collection system (shown in red on the attached map). Upon completion of this comprehensive sewer system inspection, the Town will have a complete updated inventory of all the assets within the sewer collection system and a list of needed repairs ranked by severity. This information will become an invaluable resource for the development of a long-range municipal sewer system maintenance and repair plan.
