Q. At last week's meeting the Moderator made the specific recommendation that he felt the best form of government was a Council/Manager. I didn't hear any follow up by the Commission members on why he believed this. Do you intend to follow up on this?

Q. The Moderator went on about a precinct chair meeting he attended where the article about the Brook Road bridge was discussed and commented about how informing the discussion was given that JB and abutters were present on the issue. Given that the precinct chairs represent 1/15 of Town Meeting and even with other presentations less than half of Town Meeting will never hear the discussion, wouldn't it be much better off this discussion were held on the floor of Town Meeting? If this were a city council, meeting frequently all legislators could participate and vote after hearing all the issues.

Q. Is there any plan to submit two charter options to the voters, one for a council form of government and the second for continuing Town Meeting?
