

WHAT CAN BE DONE TO DETER GRAFFITI?

- Prevention is the key to help keep Plymouth beautiful. Property owners must keep property clean and neat. A well kept building is less of a canvas for taggers than a run down building.
- Prompt removal of graffiti reduces reoccurrences of graffiti. If graffiti is removed within the first 24-48 hours, it will make taggers think twice about using their supplies on a building that is being watched and kept up.
- Control access to the building. Increased lighting installed.

WHAT IS GRAFFITI?

Graffiti is marking, drawing, etching (or other methods) on public or private property without the owners' permission. Usually done by an individual or group to gain recognition from peers but it is a crime!

HOW DOES GRAFFITI HURT A COMMUNITY?

Graffiti can affect the local economy. Its presence can make a community seem neglected and cause a downturn in the property value of an area. Vacant buildings with graffiti are less likely to be leased or sold causing economic problems for that area.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I SEE GRAFFITI?

If you see graffiti, you should report it to the authorities as it is a crime.

You should also take pictures of the graffiti. Taggers generally use the same symbol to help them be identified.
