CONSERVATION COMMISSION

**RECOMMENDATION: Not Approve (Unanimous 0-12-0)**

The Advisory & Finance Committee reconsidered their recommendation for Article 11 due to receipt of the below letter from Diane Peck, Chair, Open Space Committee dated September 28, 2020 notifying the committee that the Open Space Committee had voted unanimously to withdraw Article 11 from the Town Meeting due to discrepancies with the deed/title study that require additional research and Town Counsel review. The Open Space Committee will continue vetting these tax title properties and be re-evaluated for presentation in the future.

To whom it may concern:

On September 24, 2020, the Open Space Committee voted unanimously to withdraw Article 11 - the conveyance of two ocean beach lots abutting Landing Way, off Ellisville Road, from Tax Title Status to Conservation - from the Fall 2020 Town Meeting warrant.

A deed/title study revealed discrepancies that require additional research and an opinion from Town Counsel, which will exceed the time frame before Fall Town Meeting. The committee therefore recommends that Article 11 be removed from the Warrant until a date yet to be determined, "No Motion, No Action."

The committee's vetting of these tax title properties will continue with additional input from town departments and the Plymouth public and be re-evaluated for presentation in the future.
