



2025 Notice of Changes to Town Water & Sewer Rates

To continue providing quality operation and maintenance of water and sewer systems, while supporting water conservation efforts, the Town of Plymouth will implement new water and sewer rates for all bills issued after June 30, 2025.

New Water and Sewer Rates

8 ccf - low use	\$ 154.85	\$ 164.17
13 ccf - average use	\$ 211.47	\$ 224.21
45 ccf - high use	\$ 693.08	\$ 735.10

Summer Quarterly Bill Examples

Water Only

**Summertime rates do not apply to sewer bills

Usage	Current (FY25)	New (FY26)
8 ccf - low use	\$ 39.46	\$ 43.07
13 ccf - average use	\$ 53.60	\$ 58.49
45 ccf - high use	\$ 176.53	\$ 192.40

Why Are Rates Increasing?

The FY26 rate increase was recommended based on the 2024 Water & Sewer rate study. Current rates have been set to fund critical infrastructure maintenance and replacement, some of which is over 75 years old.

Adoption of summertime usage rates is designed to help promote water conservation efforts. Summertime rates apply to water usage only in the months of July, August, and September.

Tips for Conserving Water

Certain summer activities consume more water than others, including, but not limited to, lawn irrigation, filling swimming pools, and washing cars. Following the seasonal non-essential outdoor water schedule can help decrease overall water consumption. Beginning in July, the Town of Plymouth's Water Division will offer a limited number of water conservation kits on a first-come, first-served basis.
