Title	Memorial Hall Alcohol Policy

1. PURPOSE

To safely clear Memorial Hall at the conclusion of the show, manage intoxicated individuals, and ensure the safety of both patrons and staff as the event wraps up for the night. A last call gives patrons a buffer to finish their drinks and leave the event when the show is complete.

2. GUIDELINES

The alcohol policy for events at Memorial Hall requires the event promoter/certificate holder of the one-day liquor license to end all alcohol sales at least 30 minutes prior to the end of the scheduled event.

Memorial Hall enforces a "Card Everyone" policy. This means anyone wishing to buy alcohol must present valid identification. Acceptable forms of identification include a state issued driver's license, a Massachusetts state ID, or a United States passport.

It is recognized that bartenders have the authority to refuse alcohol service to anyone they believe is intoxicated. This responsibility ensures the safety of patrons and promotes a responsible drinking environment.

Memorial Hall reserves the right to close any bar or concession stand if it believes that Town Policy is not being adhered to.
