

PLYMOUTH HARBOR MOORING PLAN

Dear Mooring Holder,

As you may have heard, the Army Corp of Engineers (ACOE) will be dredging the Plymouth Harbor entrance channel and the federal anchorage (mooring field) starting this October. This is a very exciting time for us and we are very lucky to have ACOE investing in Plymouth Harbor!

Due to the dredging time of year restrictions (October 1st – January 15th), this project will be completed over the next two years. It is a requirement of the ACOE to have all moorings removed from the anchorage and channel buffer to allow the contractor to dredge the area. This is a major task and there will be impacts to the mooring holders before, during and possibly after construction.

While the moorings are removed we will be working to develop a mooring plan to use the space efficiently, provide a logical grid layout, make the mooring field user friendly and make sure all moorings are in compliance with ACOE regulations. This mooring plan will affect all mooring holders, not just those in the federal anchorage.

The Harbormaster Office with the Harbor Committee will be hosting a couple of public meetings to discuss the mooring plan. We hope to go over dredging timelines and discuss the mooring plan project to answer any questions you may have. We will maintain a Mooring Plan folder on our website with helpful updates and information. We also hope to record and televise the meeting on PACTV for those who are unable to attend.
