

## Town Clerk Services during the Town Hall Shutdown

- Marriage Intentions – We are unable to process Marriage Intentions (applying) until we reopen. For those who already applied, call 508-322-3302 and leave a voice mail. I have the intentions at my home, and we can make arrangements. Justice of the Peace services may be available for very small outdoor services for those with marriage certificates.
- Nominations for Town Election – If you make a last minute decision to seek Town Office, email the Town Clerk at [lpizer@townhall.plymouth.ma.us](mailto:lpizer@townhall.plymouth.ma.us). Those papers are due back by 5 pm on Friday, 3/27. If you have papers completed, scan them and email them to me AND either mail them or place them in the delivery drop box at the upper entrance to Town Hall. Unhappily, there are no extensions based on the virus.
- Election of March 31 for State Senate has been postponed until 5/19. As we get closer, we shall let you know about early voting, absentee voting, etc.
- Town Election – As of now, it remains scheduled for 5/16.
- Business Certificates – Look on this website to see how to apply by mail. It will require a notary. You might wish to wait until we reopen.
- Dog licenses – Best to apply online. We were close to catching up on our backlog when Town Hall closure occurred.
- Birth Certificate certified copies – Best to apply online. The Clerk may have occasional access.
- Death Certificate certified copies – I am able to register deaths during the closure, so when/if I am able to go to Town Hall, I can fulfill those orders.
- Notary Services – Not available.
