Brief Description of Repair Work:

- The issuance of a Repair Permit only allows for the damaged area to be brought back to its originally permitted condition based on previously approved Orders of Conditions. Any configuration changes *will* require the filing of a new Notice of Intent.
- If a Repair Permit is granted, standard conditions will be issued. These conditions must be followed throughout the life of the Six (6) Month Repair Permit.
- The Commission reserves the right to impose additional conditions, as necessary, to protect the interests of the Wetlands Protection Act and the Plymouth Wetlands Protection By-Law.
- If any repair work involves encroachment or transporting equipment over Town Property, please contact the *Town Managers Office* as there may be a license required prior to the commencement of work.
- Please contact the *Inspection Services Dept.* to ensure that no other permits are required.
